What is encrypted email?

Encrypting an e-mail message protects the privacy of the message by converting it from (readable) plaintext into (scrambled) ciphertext. Anyone intercepting the email in transit would see only garbled text.

Why do we need it?

To protect Non-Public Personal Information (NPI) by ensuring that our emails and attachments are sent securely. Investors Title strives to achieve the highest standards established by the **ALTA Best Practices**.

What should you expect?

When you receive an email containing NPI from Investors Title:

- 1. If Investors Title is able to establish a secure connection to your email system/provider, you will not notice any change in the way emails are delivered.
- 2. If Investors Title is not able to establish a secure connection to your email system/provider, you will receive an email with a link to access the secure email and its contents.
- 3. Usernames or passwords are not required to access the encrypted email and its contents!
